# March 25, 2018- Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Every Palm Sunday gives me a flashback of my childhood. When I was growing up, my daddy or my older brother would cut the tender and most central branch of the coconut tree. I decorated it with flowers and walked to the church. During the ceremony, the Pastor would invite all the boys who had a coconut branch in front of the altar. After a short prayer he would bless our branches with the Holy water. We would raise the branches as high as we could to get the Holy water and also to compete and prove that “I have the tallest branch.” Then we all led the procession into the church singing in honor of Christ “hosanna.”

Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus’ triumphal entry into Jerusalem. It marks the beginning of Holy Week: the suffering death and Resurrection of Christ. Palm Sunday was the “beginning of the end” of Jesus’ work on Earth. The Gospel records the arrival of Jesus riding on a donkey, while the crowds spread their cloaks and palm branches on the street and shouted “Hosanna to the Son of David” and “blessed is he that comes in the name of the Lord.”

I always wondered why Jesus rode on a donkey and not a horse which would have appeared more solemn and noble. I found the answer in the regional custom of Jesus’ time. The donkey was a symbol of peace and those who rode upon them proclaimed peaceful intentions. Moreover the triumphant and victorious king always looked at God as the ultimate ruler and thus riding on a donkey depicted the king’s humility.

Palm Sunday is an occasion for reflecting on the final week of Jesus’ life. It is a time for us to prepare ourselves for the agony and passion of our Savior. Let us pause for a while and spiritually enter into Holy Week.

Today, during the mass, recall the words of the crowd and join the Angels in singing:
