March 28th, 2021 - Palm Sunday



Those preceding Jesus as well as those following kept crying out: "Hosanna!

Blessed is he who comes in

the name of the Lord! Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is to

come! Hosanna in the highest!"

-Mark 15:45-47

Save Us Lord Jesus, Please, We Beseech Thee

The Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord always brings back to my mind the tradition of my state when I was growing up. My older brother or my daddy would cut the fresh tender yellowish unfurled palm leaves from the center of the trees. My sister would visit me to decorate the leaf with different flowers. Then the whole family would walk towards the church. It was a treat for the eyes to see so many young boys holding their palm leaves in the streets walking to the church. There was always a competition to see whose palm leaf was tallest.

The whole congregation would assemble in the square at the foot of the Christ the King statue. The priest would then bless the palm leaves and we would raise them higher to receive the Holy water. After returning home, we would pluck the blades of the palm leaf and make crosses to hang in rooms and to give to neighbors who didn't have any. The celebration of Palm Sunday was a joyous occasion for every teenager. Since they are blessed, these palms are not disposed of like ordinary palms. They are saved and turned into the church the following year to make ashes for Ash Wednesday.

It was a joyous moment for the people in Jerusalem when Jesus entered. They had acknowledged Him as their king and leader. Hence, with pomp and splendor, they welcomed their new "ruler to be." Such a welcome was normally showered upon a victorious king, who had returned home after a successful victory.

Jesus was rightfully called the *Son of David*. It didn't mean that He was a literal son of David, but that He was a descendant of King David and a rightful ruler based on a promise that God had made with David.

Every time at Mass, before the consecration of Bread and wine, we all acclaim Jesus a king in the same words used 2,000 years ago "Hosanna." In simple terms it means "Please save us." It is a Greek word based on two Hebrew words "Yasha" which means "save or deliver" and "anna" which means "please, I beseech."

During this Palm Sunday let us call on our Lord Jesus to 'save us' from our trials and tribulations, from sin and temptation. May He deliver us from evil. Have a blessed and Spirit filled Holy week.


